Paying bills probably isn't your favorite pastime, so West Florida Electric Cooperative strives to make the chore as convenient as possible for you. Take advantage of the following easy payment options the next time your WFEC bill is due:

Levelized billing

After one year of service, WFEC can base your monthly charges on an average of the previous 12 months' actual energy use for your home. If you're on a fixed income and don't like surprises, levelized billing helps you plan ahead.

Bank draft bill payment

Your monthly electric bill can be paid directly from your bank account. Bank draft payment and levelized billing are a perfect combination if you're a frequent traveler.

Double notification

At your request, WFEC will notify a third party when an account is delinquent – an ideal option if you're a landlord or caregiver.

Collection points

On or before the due date, pay your WFEC bill at Regions Bank in Chipley, Blountstown and Marianna (both locations); C & L Bank in Blountstown and Altha; or PCB, The Community Bank, in Marianna, Greenwood and Malone – even if you aren't a bank customer.

Credit card payments

WFEC accepts all major credit cards.
